About the Investigator and His Research in Forgiveness

Dr. Miles Hewstone studied Psychology at the University of Bristol, and obtained his D.Phil. from Oxford University in 1981, and his *Habilitation* from the University of Tübingen in 1986. He then undertook post-doctoral work with Serge Moscovici (in Paris) and Wolfgang Stroebe (in Tübingen). He has held chairs in Social Psychology at the University of Bristol, University of Mannheim, and Cardiff University. He is now at Oxford University. He has published widely on the topics of attribution theory, social cognition, stereotyping, and intergroup relations. His current work centers on the reduction of intergroup conflict, via intergroup contact, stereotype change and crossed categorization. He is a former editor of the *British Journal of Social Psychology*, and co-founding editor of the *European Review of Social Psychology*. He is a past recipient of the British Psychological Society's Spearman Medal, and has twice been a Fellow at the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences, Stanford (1987-88, 1999-00).
