About the Investigator and Her Research in Forgiveness

Dr. Jennie Noll is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Cincinnati, Children's Hospital Medical Center (CCHMC) in Cincinnati, Ohio, USA. She is a developmental psychologist and holds a joint appointment in the division of Psychology and the Mayerson Center for Safe and Healthy Children at CCHMC. Her research has been supported by numerous federal and foundation grants, and is primarily concerned with the long-term bio-psych-social effects of childhood abuse on female development. After receiving her grant from the John Templeton Foundation in 1998, Dr. Noll moved from the University of Southern California to Cincinnati, where she continues to study forgiveness. She recently has reviewed the research on forgiveness and trauma and has collaborated with Dr. Michael McCullough in an empirical study of trauma and forgiveness.
