About the Investigator and His Research in Forgiveness

Lindon Eaves, Ph.D., D.Sc., is Distinguished Professor of Human Genetics and Psychiatry at Virginia Commonwealth University School of Medicine in Richmond and directs the Virginia Institute for Psychiatric and Behavioral Genetics. His research encompasses statistical genetics and the genetics of human behavior, with a special emphasis on genetic studies of behavioral development, and the modeling of biological and cultural inheritance. He is past-president of the Behavior Genetics Association and has received numerous honors and awards for his contributions to behavioral genetics and twin research. He has authored more than 200 papers and a book, *Genes, Culture and Personality: An Empirical Approach*. He is an Episcopal Priest in the Diocese of Virginia and has lectured widely on the relationship between science and theology. Dr. Eaves has continued to study the heritability of forgiveness within the Virginia Twin Registry. He has also collaborated with Dr. Ming Tsuang and colleagues at Harvard University in studies of genetic influences on forgiveness.
